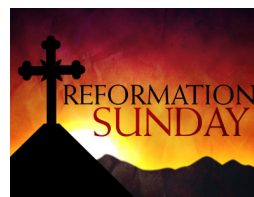

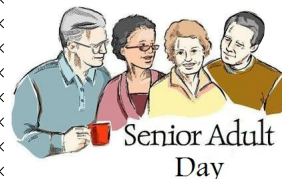


REFORMATION SUNDAY
