PASTOR'S PRAYER PARTNERS

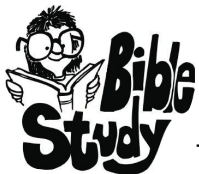

IRON SHARPENERS/CROSSROADS GALS

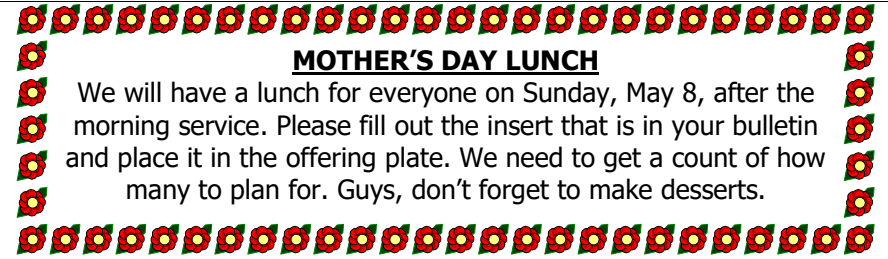
The Iron Sharpners will be gathering at the church on Thursday, May 5, at 7 PM for a time of Bible Study and fellowship.
